AVONDALE SCHOOLS NAMED BEST IN THE COUNTRY

Avondale Elementary School District was recognized in the first-ever US News rankings for public elementary and middle schools.

The publication included kinder through eighth grade public schools. AESD earned a total of seven recognitions for their schools in Goodyear.

Two schools earned the Best Elementary recognition and five schools were recognized as the Best Middle School.

US News analyzed more than one hundred thousand schools in Arizona. Rankings are based on the schools that place in the top thirty percent in the state. According to the organization, schools were assessed on their students' proficiencies in mathematics and reading, as measured by state assessments.

AESD has continuously been recognized at the state and national level in recent years for their high achievement in academics and professional development. Having the highest percentage of A Rated schools in the southwest valley, the district is a leader in public education in Arizona.

PERFECT SCORES ON AZ MERIT ASSESSMENT

Thirty three elementary school students received a perfect score on the annual Arizona MERIT state assessment. Third through eighth grade students excelled with a one-hundred percent grade point in the statewide 2021 achievement test. Two of those students excelled on both the math and ELA exams and two additional students received a perfect score for the second consecutive year.

Students, along with their families, were celebrated at the district's governing board meeting.
